### **Purpose of Processing**

1. Management of grant/partnership applications;
2. Disbursement of grants following assessment;
3. Compliance with advertising obligations under regulations (website, transparent administration, anti-mafia, DURC) as part of activities aimed at assisting users and providing useful information.

### **Legal Basis for Processing**

The legal bases include the need to perform a task in the public interest, compliance with legal obligations, execution of a task of significant public interest, grant of economic benefits, and specific regulations.

### **External Data Processors**

Personal data may be communicated to external subjects formally appointed by the Chamber of Commerce as Data Processors providing technical/information technology services and/or database management and maintenance services for the Data Controller (for example Infocamere scpa, Infocert)

### **Other Recipients of Data**

For reasons related to the conduct of activities, data may also be communicated to entities holding databases, the national state aid register (RNA), the Ministry of Economic Development (MISE), the National Agricultural Information System (SIAN) (MIPAAF), public administrations, the Ministry of Economy and Finance (MEF), and the Prefecture.

### **Data Disclosure**

Data, limited to those provided for by transparency regulations (Legislative Decree no. 33/2013 and subsequent amendments), will be published in the "Transparency Administration" section and on the institutional website (lists and roster of beneficiaries of economic contributions).

### **Data Transfer Abroad**

There is no provision for transferring data to countries outside the European Union (EU).

### **Data Retention Periods**

- Data related to the assessment: 10 years
- Reporting of calls for proposals: unlimited period of time.

### **Nature of Data Provision and Consequences of Failure to Provide Data**

The provision of the requested data is mandatory. Failure to provide the data will result in the inability to continue with the administrative procedure.

### **Rights of the Data Subject**

At the Chamber of Commerce, the Data Subject can exercise the following rights as provided by Regulation (EU) 2016/679:

- Article 15 (Right of access by the data subject)
- Article 16 (Right to rectification)
- Article 17 (Right to erasure or "right to be forgotten")
- Article 18 (Right to restriction of processing)
- Article 19 (Obligation to notify in case of rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing)
- Article 20 (Right to data portability)
- Article 21 (Right to object)
- Article 22 (Automated individual decision-making, including profiling)
- Article 77 (Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority).

In any case, the Data Subject also has the right to lodge a formal complaint with the supervisory authority for data protection (Article 77) according to the procedures available on the authority's website [www.garanteprivacy.it](http://www.garanteprivacy.it).
